Billy Vance Myers, 70, was born August 31, 1941 in Aurora, Illinois to Burness C. and Bernice D. (Berger) Myers. Bill passed away on Thursday, July 19, 2012 at his home in Ephrata after a brief battle with leukemia.

Bill graduated from Quincy High School in 1959. His family moved to Ephrata in the fall of 1959 from Quincy, WA. He married Della M. Miller on December 2, 1961 at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Ephrata.

He was a volunteer fire fighter and chief for Grant County Fire District #13 for 32 years.

Bill worked for Celite Corp. in Quincy for nearly 40 years. He was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church; Grant County Historical Society; and Desert Coachmen Car Club.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents Burness & Bernice Myers.
