Donald A. Dunbar, 87, of Ephrata, Washington, passed away on Sunday, August 18, 2013 at

Columbia Basin Hospital in Ephrata.

He was born to Ted and Gladys Dunbar on November 26, 1925 in Almeria, Nebraska and moved to South Dakota in 1930 where he went through school and graduated from Marty High School, Marty, South Dakota in 1944.
