Dora Maude Ream, 91, of Ephrata, Wa passed away on Saturday, October 18, 2014 at Columbia Basin Hospital in Ephrata. She was born in Avard, OK on March 17, 1923 to Mr. & Mrs. Leon Johnson. Dora graduated from Avard high school as Validictorian, and was a member of the Honor Society. She attended NorthWestern State College where she was a member of the Future Homemakers Club, and became an Alumni Association Life member. This is where she received her Bachelor of Science Degree from and shortly after graduating the state of Oklahoma issued her a Public School Teaching Certificate. She married Harold M. Ream on November 20, 1943 in Avard, OK. Dora's family moved to Ephrata, Washington shortly after graduating.
