Ed Maw, 73, passed away with his family by his side October 8, 2024. He was born in Chelan, Washington in 1951, to Vernon and Neva Maw. He joined three older sisters. The family lived in Mansfield, WA where he grew up and graduated from Mansfield High School in 1969. He attended Wenatchee Valley College.
