Faye Tina (Gardner) Logg was welcomed into the arms of her Savior, Jesus Christ 27 June, 2022.

Faye was born in Greenville, North Carolina in 1936. She married a handsome young U.S. Marine and moved west to Coulee City, Washington in June of 1964. The beautiful young lady brought 4 children into the world and when asked how old she was, would always reply, "I'm just turning 39" followed by a sheepish grin and a light chuckle.

She was a long standing member of the Assembly of God Church of Coulee City and when relatives came to visit, her first greeting was always a question: How are you with your Faith?" She would then tell you how much she loved you, and would always add the little tidbit, that God loves you too.

Our beloved Faye was preceded in death by her husband of 35 years, Gary Logg (died 1998), and her son Vernon Logg who passed in 2005. She will be watching at Heaven's gate for those she left behind, which includes Leonard and Isaac Logg and daughter Gwendolynn (Logg) Burkhalter of Sturgis, South Dakota.

Her surviving siblings Harry and James Gardner of North Carolina will be in our thoughts and prayers.

Faye also leaves behind 27 Grandchildren and several Great-Grandchildren and who knows what tomorrow may bring.
