March 4, 1944 - May 21, 2023

Paul Mauch, 79, of Soap Lake, WA, passed away on May 21, 2023.

Paul was born in Toppenish, WA, to Ronald and Helen Mauch in the Bozarth Nursing Home on March 4th, 1944. At the age of five, his family relocated to Tacoma, WA, where he graduated from Wilson High School in 1963. Paul went on to join the Army in 1965 where he served as a special weapons advisor and then later as a baker in the Big Red 1, until getting out in 1970. Paul's passion for cooking didn't end there. He enjoyed his role as a chef at The Boat House Grill at Point Defiance, until switching careers and receiving a diploma for his successful role as an industrial steel worker at Tacoma Smelter on the Tacoma Tide flats.

Paul and Marla Rogers were married in September 1977, and spent 46 years together, fishing for Walleye in Moses Lake, clam digging in Grayland, and organizing 10 of Blue Lakes's best fishing derbys in Grant County.

Paul devoted 10 of his most cherished years to becoming a minister, and spent countless hours at rehab centers all over Grays Harbor where he was loved by everyone. After he retired, he enjoyed fishing and grafting trees in his orchards (sometimes up to 30 grafts on one tree!), but he never stopped putting God first in his life.

Paul was a beloved husband, father, and faithful Minister in Christ. He is survived by Marla Mauch, his wife of 46 years, his oldest son Robert T. King and partner Clay Concanon, younger son Curtiss A. King and fiance Samantha Nairn, and a sister and brother amongst many other relatives and

friends.
