Sean Carver Witte, 29, of Quincy, Washington, beloved son, brother, and friend to all, passed away suddenly Thursday, February 2, 2023 from a vehicle accident.

He was born December 20, 1993 in Wenatchee, Washington to Tom and Terri Witte. He attended St. Rose of Lima Catholic School from preschool to fourth grade, where he mostly followed the janitor around. He then went on to graduate in 2012 from Ephrata High School. Following graduation Sean attended Walla Walla Community College and earned an Associate Degree and John Deere Technical Program Certification. Sean recently began his own business, Sean's Repair Service, in a shop his Uncle Rock Witte and several friends helped him remodel.
