



## Willeta Morgan

Willeta Noreen Morgan, 88, passed away on November 8, 2024, in Ephrata, Washington with her children by her side. She had been living at home for several years battling Dementia and Parkinson's disease.

Willeta or "Billie" as she preferred was born in Garrison, Minnesota on December 10, 1935, to William and Dorris Lee. bowled a perfect game of 300. Billie especially enjoyed gatherings with her family.
