June 11, 1924 - February 12, 2012

William R. Anderson, 87, was a longtime Ephrata, Washington resident.

He was born in Seattle, Washington on June 11, 1924.

Bill was a Longfellow

from 1939 to 1943 in Garfield, Washington. In March, 1943 he was drafted by the United States Army right out of high school and served until April, 1946.

He was called back for further duty serving Aug. 1950-Oct. 1951.

After his stint in the service Bill went to business college to be an accountant, working for a CPA firm, various other businesses and his own bookkeeping and tax service. In 1962 he was an accountant for the World's Fair in Seattle.

From 1964 to 1969 Bill worked for Boeing and then moved to Ephrata with his wife, Helen, where they began their own business – Sun Basin Nutrition Centre – closing the store in 1985.

Bill became a born again Christian when Helen became sick and his beloved wife died in 1976 ... Matthew 6:33.

He served God sharing His word in prisons, writing thousands of letters, and doing street work around the world.

Bill is survived by his daughter, Kay Anderson of Leavenworth, Wash.; his brother, Gerald (Ginny) Anderson of Seattle; his nephew, Wade Anderson of Seattle and his niece, Barbara Anderson of Seattle.
