Zoe Anderson, 86 of Ephrata passed away after a brief illness on Sunday, December 17, 2023. She learned from her Aunt Faye Morris how to make braided rugs and had many of them in her home. She also enjoyed going to the ocean at Long Beach

where the family has a cabin and she could sit and enjoy the beautiful beach sunsets for hours on end.

She was a fixture at her daughters sign shop in Ephrata where she would get her daily dose of what she called her free retched coffee. She lived a simple life and enjoyed whatever life had to offer and rarely complained about anything.
